ABSTRACT

Organizational citizenship behaviour is regarded as an explanation of employee performance which is crucial to make greater contributions to the process and success of the organization. Therefore, it is essential to understand the factors affecting employees' organizational citizenship behaviour to improve organizational effectiveness and achieve its goals. Manufacturing sector is an economic engine that drives innovation and growth by creating jobs and improving life through providing goods and services, they play a vital role in the global economy. This previous study has focused on positive behavioural outcomes to investigate the POS and OCB; however, there are negative behavioural outcomes that may be negatively influenced due to POS, like counterproductive behaviours; The current study aims to fill this gap in the literature.
