Enhancing Students Engagement: The Role of Classpoint in Promoting Active Learning amongst Students in Higher Learning Instituition

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ABSTRACT

One of the approaches to promote active learning in higher education is ClassPoint. As a result of this instructors do not need to switch to other application during their teaching. The use of ClassPoint in teaching would enhance active learning amongst learners and also make them responsible for their learning. Students can engage in group discussions, problem-solving activities, and other interactive exercises that promote critical thinking and deeper comprehension of the subject matter.
